Beau Vigne was founded in 2002 by Ed Snider. Although we fly under the radar as a small boutique winery, we do so with impressive stature and enjoy our “hidden gem” status. We are world renown and recognized by wine critics as a winery that produces exceptional, intense, balanced, rich and multidimensional wines.

TASTING NOTES

Inspired by the great Cabernets of Napa Valley, our Heritage North Coast Cabernet Sauvignon is a stunner. It showcases bold, dark fruit flavors of blackberry and cassis, harmoniously balanced with subtle oak nuances. A well-structured body, with firm tannins and a lingering finish make it a timeless representation of the classic California Cabernet.

VINTAGE DESCRIPTION

In 2021, all of the North Coast (Napa Valley, Sonoma, Mendocino) experienced a dream vintage with even ripeness, and flowering. It will be remembered for low yields with intensely-flavored, small-sized berries and a smooth and uneventful harvest season. The season started off with very little rain, leading to the 2nd year of drought conditions in region. The drought of resulted in a more natural load on the vines, requiring less pruning and dropping of fruit. The resulting grapes are packed full of flavor, including our HERITAGE Cabernet Sauvignon.
